~ Special Note About Park Entrance Fees and Parking ~

This is especially important for those who are coming on Sunday afternoon to help with cleanup.

If you plan to leave anytime before 5:00 PM, you must move your car back to the main parking lot by 10:00 AM. Driving on the park paths during park hours is restricted.
